2018 Bold Ideas Challen

In January 2018 President Castro invited the campus again to submit Bold Ideas to improve services to students or improve an inefficient process.

72 ideas were submitted.

A diverse group of faculty and staff members (CAIFE Alumni) reviewed and ranked the ideas and provided feedback to the Cabinet. The Cabinet has identified 13 winners and 10 projects to pursue in the coming year as part of the Creativity and Innovation for Effectiveness (CAIFE) initiative. In the coming weeks new CAIFE teams will be named to implement the Bold Ideas selected. The CAIFE teams will participate in professional development and will work to implement the ideas in 2018/19.

The balance of ideas submitted will be passed to the appropriate department for consideration.



2018 Bold Ideas Winners

Strategic Priority One

Dr. Susan Schlievert, Curriculum and Instruction

Dr. Jennifer Randles, Sociology

Susan proposed creating a Kids Locker, a bring and take space for families. Jennifer's idea was to create a diaper bank for parenting students. Drs. Schlievert and Randle's ideas will be combined to address the needs of parenting students

Dr. James Marshall, Research and Graduate Studies Establish The Graduate School at Fresno State in order to enhance graduate education.

Dr. Ram Nunna, Lyles College of Engineering

Create a mobile app that will provide students a graphical representation of their progress towards their degree.

Dr. Tamas Forgacs, Mathematics

Dr. John Walkup, Physics

Drs. Forgacs and Walkup both submitted similar ideas, which have been combined for one project – to establish a center or clearinghouse for Undergraduate Research.

Jonathan proposed implementing a formal campus wide staff recognition program. Matthew's idea was to unify the campus digital badging credential program for faculty, staff and students. The Cabinet was inspired by both ideas and have combined them. The CAIFE team will be charged with exploring a comprehensive faculty and staff recognition program to include digital badging.

Create a We Are Fresno State advocacy and awareness participatory video with LGBTQ+ students, faculty and staff.

Create a student assistant mentor program. The Cabinet was excited about this idea and will convene a CAIFE team to address professional development for student assistants.
